- ◆ Bring the "Asthma Friendly Child Care Checklist" to your child care provider to talk about controlling triggers.

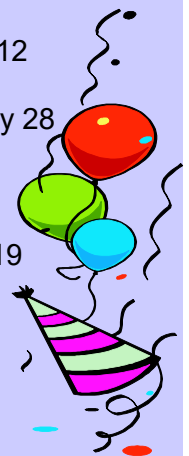

## Toddler I News from Miss Lisa

As we begin the month of May, we hope that we will continue to enjoy the warm and beautiful 'spring days. (you can apply sunscreen before bringing your child to the preschool. We also recommend hats for added sun protection.) This month we will be discussing how seeds grow into plants. What needs to happen for the seed to grow? Next we will learn about Bees and Butterflies.

The children will be as busy as bees as they buzz from flower to flower, gathering sweet ideas. Learn how to be a beekeeper and listen to the bees communicate. Then, follow a bee inside your own make-believe honeycomb. Get to know the queen bee and other jobs in the hive. Outside, watch a brand new butterfly appear.

Our class will hear stories about a caterpillar who was wrapped up in a chrysalis and went through a process of metamorphosis. Experience the life cycles of bees and butterflies this spring with your children. We will learn what do bees do? What is in a beehive? What do butterflies do? Where do butterflies come from?
